By the end of this course students will be able to:

L1V.01D Read and demonstrate an understanding of a variety of literary and informational texts (from contemporary and historical periods) (Applied and Academic)

L1V.02D Demonstrate an understanding of the elements of a variety of literary and informational forms, with a focus on plays, short stories, magazines, newspapers. (Applied)
